In the medieval town of Beaumaris, 13th-century Beaumaris Castle has concentric fortifications and a moat.





In this new contract, engineers from <u>PTSG Water Treatment Ltd</u> will be carrying out a range of quarterly water hygiene and legionella monitoring activities such as routine flushing, descaling and temperature monitoring.
