

<u>Triangle Housing Association selects SPIE</u> <u>for Fire & Security</u>

On top of this, SPIE will provide a 24-hour reactive response and repairs service across all of Triangle Housing's properties.

The framework contract has been signed for an initial 36 months, with the option to extend it by a further 36 months if both parties agree to.
