

Owen Stanford wins first-ever #BMFamily award at BM Foodies

Owen Stanford has been named as the first-ever winner of the BMFamily award at the company's annual BM FOODIES Awards celebrations.

Owen received the award for the work he has done around mental health with the #BMFamily and wider society, including offering support to colleges during the pandemic, alongside being on call for community-based search and rescue teams.
