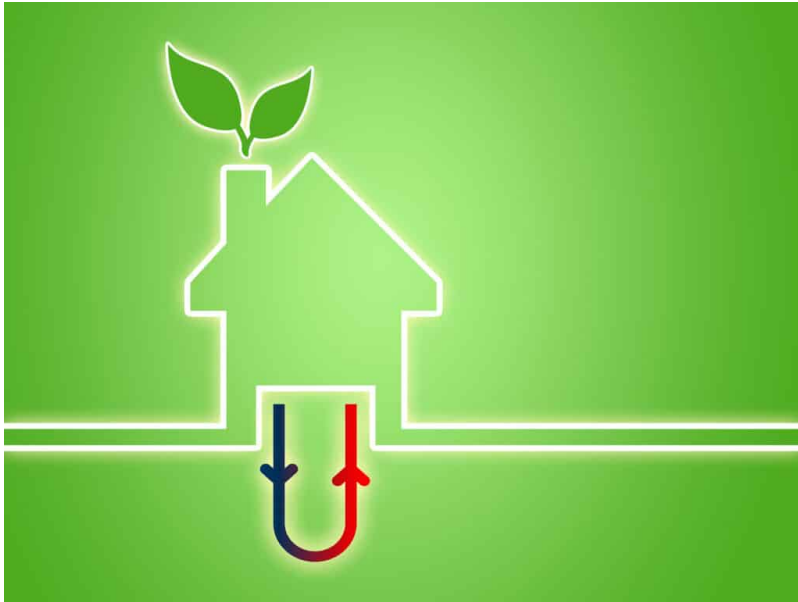


An additional five firms join CO2nstruct Zero

CO2nstruct Zero is the industry's united response to the need to drive carbon out of construction. The initiative continues to gain momentum as five more companies from across the broad spectrum of construction have signed up to become CO2nstruct Zero Business Champions.

CO2nstruct Zero was launched last year to unify industry efforts to cut carbon. The campaign focusses on nine priorities including moves to zero emission plant, retrofitting existing buildings, measuring carbon use and developing low carbon materials.
