The PDSA's fundraising team said "These funds will go towards helping our vets treat the pets we see in our hospitals. The money you have donated will help pay towards 10 days' worth of oxygen, 5 life-saving drips and 5 full courses of antibiotics used during surgery at our 48 Pet Hospitals."
