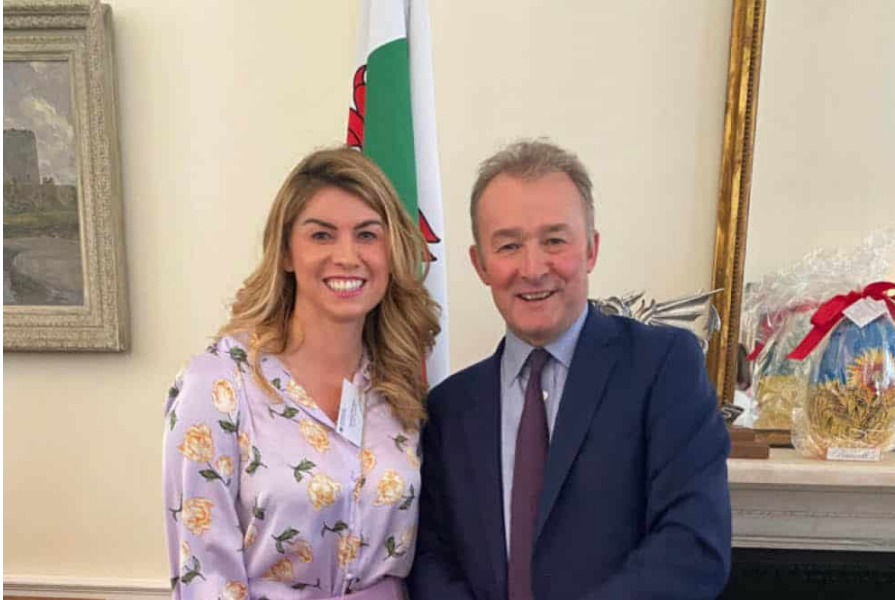


Mrs Buckét visits Whitehall for celebratory event
