PTSG to safeguard London's Green Quarter

<u>Premier Technical Services Group Ltd (PTSG)</u> has been contracted to deliver specialist electrical services at a major new mixed-site development in West London.

Southall Gas Works is a former gas works site of around 88 acres in Southall, west London. It is currently being redeveloped for mixed-use including 3,750 homes as part of Berkeley Group's The Green Quarter, originally known as Southall Waterside due to its location in Southall, four miles to the east of Heathrow. The first affordable homes were finished in early 2019, with the first private residents arriving in 2021.

In August 2021, the first phase of a new public park at The Green Quarter opened, called Central Gardens. The park has new trees, wildflowers and an amphitheatre, and is used for local community events. When complete, the park will be 4.5 acres in size and contain 250 trees as well as a water feature. Central Gardens is one of two new parks at The Green Quarter, with new wetlands also to be created on the site.

Engineers from <u>PTSG Electrical Services Ltd</u> have been contracted to install a brand-new lightning protection system at the development. This will ensure protection of the building and all users in the event of an electrical storm

The Essex office of PTSG Electrical Services Ltd (trading as JW Gray) is thought to be the oldest trading provider of lightning protection services in the UK, possibly even Europe. It was established in 1835.
