

Morgan Sindall Property Services Signs New Contract with Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council

MSPS will take over the maintenance contract from Mears Limited in October this year, for a period of up to ten years. As part of their commitment to partnership working, MSPS will be co-located with WHBC staff at council offices in Campus East, Welwyn Garden City.

Councillor Tony Kingsbury said: "We are very much looking forward to working collaboratively with Morgan Sindall Property Services to provide a housing maintenance service that is focused on our residents and their needs. This new maintenance contract will use state-of-the-art technology to manage responsive and planned works with real time customer updates on repairs status, whilst providing more opportunities for customers to feedback on the quality of service they receive."
