

Topping out ceremony at One Central Argyle Street as Multiplex reaches milestone

<u>Multiplex</u> has announced that One Central Argyle Street has topped out, marking a major milestone in the project's delivery.

Designed by Cooper Cromar, the Argyle Street Project is a 15-storey office building. The new development will add an iconic building to the Glasgow skyline within the city centre financial district.
