Veolia had announced the execution of a unilateral put agreement whereby Macquarie Asset Management irrevocably undertakes to acquire 100% of the share capital of Suez Recycling and Recovery UK Group, regrouping Suez waste activities in the UK.

Following completion of this antitrust remedy, Veolia will remain a major player in the UK waste management market with revenues of approximately €2 billion.

In business, <u>Ramboll</u> and <u>Wates Facilities Management (FM)</u> have signed a new long-term contract for Total Facilities Management services in the UK.

The agreement, which begins on 1 September, will cover services such as security, cleaning, full hard service provision including asset maintenance and HVAC systems, building operations and maintenance of eight Ramboll offices.

As part of the contract, Wates will work alongside their supply chain partners to deliver innovations in cleaning, sustainability and maintenance through the implementation of Internet of Things technology.

Independents by Sodexo has successfully extended its partnership with the Leicester Grammar School



Trust for a further ten years.
