

Bateman House has two new occupiers on board in Cambridge

<u>Savills</u>, on behalf of Trinity Hall, has let the last remaining office space at Bateman House at 82-88 Hills Road in Cambridge to BenchSci UK Ltd and Govia Thameslink Railway Ltd respectively.

BenchSci, the firm specialising in AI assisted antibody selection, will occupy Suite A on part of the second floor of the four storey building, as well as a small office suite on the ground floor totalling 3,169 sq ft. Govia Thameslink, the train operating company, has taken Suite B on part of the second floor totalling 2,521 sq ft. Both firms have agreed to a new five-year lease.
