

## <u>Framework Charter signed with the Port of Dover</u>

Property maintenance specialist, <u>DMA Group</u>, has signed a Framework Charter with the Port of Dover to confirm its mechanical & electrical (M&E) contract with Europe's busiest port.

The event, which took place on Monday 5 December at the Port's Cruise Terminal, sets out an agreed way in which Port of Dover and DMA Group commit to working together to continue to raise standards of building maintenance and project delivery across the Port.
