

London Legacy Development Corporation Awards G4S Security Contract

The London Legacy Development Corporation has awarded [G4S](#) a four year contract to provide security services for Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park including all the open spaces, parklands, venues including London Stadium and a framework agreement to G4S for the provision of security services.

The framework will be used by the London Legacy Development Corporation, LS185 and Stratford Waterfront.

- This is a four year agreement, worth in the region of £12m.
- G4S will provide security services for the entire London Legacy Development Corporation land, venues and open spaces, ensuring availability of key roles including Security Managers, Security Team Leaders, Security Officers, CCTV Operators and Car Park Operators.
- G4S will monitor CCTV assets and systems located in the venues, public realm and wider park and using Security Control Suites.
- G4S will also provide security services at Park events including access control, ticket checks, searching and patrolling duties.
