

PTSG makes return visit to East Midlands Airport

<u>Premier Technical Services Group Ltd (PTSG)</u> has returned to East Midlands Airport to carry out vital electrical services.

This ensures compliance with the Electricity at Work Act 1989, BS 6651 and BS EN 62305.
