These individuals will be responsible for staff wellbeing and development, collaborative community projects, ESG strategy management and reporting.

Additionally, The Community and Wellbeing Manager will be responsible for managing Andron's Inclusive Futures employability programme, to develop the skills of disadvantaged people in our communities, with a particular focus on providing opportunities to individuals from a background of homelessness, careexperienced young people, and young people who are not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET).
