

Increasing European production as part of ongoing sustainability advances

[GreenTeck Global](#) has resolved to increase its European manufacturing base by 200% by the end of 2023 as part of a suite of sustainability resolutions.

The move will see the hygiene technology innovator boost the number of its eco-friendly products made in Europe from 25% to 75% by the end of the year, of which 60% will be manufactured in the UK.

In bringing the manufacturing of its alternative green technologies closer to its primary UK market, the company hopes to help customers improve their carbon footprint whilst enhancing both production and delivery times. GreenTeck Global expects the shift will help reduce lead times between order and installation by 75% for many products, down from 16 to just four weeks.

GreenTeck Global founder and CEO David Thurston said: "We've long maintained that small changes can make a big difference on many levels, while making good business sense. Championing change is in our DNA, and we regularly review our practices to see where we can find new ways to improve our own sustainability credentials.
