## PTSG bolsters defence at Sunderland

Formed in 1879, Sunderland Association Football Club plays in the Championship, the second tier of English football. In 1997, Sunderland left Roker Park and moved to the Stadium of Light, a 42,000-seat arena that, at the time, was the largest stadium built in England after the Second World War. The capacity was later increased to 49,000.

If any areas are found to need maintenance in such inspections, PTSG's engineers are fully trained and experienced to carry out the necessary work to ensure the system remains fully operational.
