In more recent times, it brought all its companies together under the banner of the HE Simm Group to offer a complete engineering and services package to its customers.

It now offers MEP, fire & security installation, maintenance, offsite manufacture and H&S consultancy services to customers in sectors including residential, commercial, education, healthcare and custodial – to name but a few.
