The new contract award reflects Mitie's strong experience in the utilities sector and follows a sequence of new contracts wins, with the company also recently landing two multimillion-pound integrated facilities management contracts with [National Grid](#).

Mitie's landscapes services have gone from strength to strength, with the company also recently acquiring Biotecture, a leading 'Living Walls' specialist, to help decarbonise built environments and support its commitment to be the greenest landscaping provider in the UK.
