

Offside capability doubled in 12 months

Engineering and service provider HE Simm Group has reported it has doubled the size of its offsite manufacturing facility, Pinnacle Offsite, after it opened just over 12 months ago to cope with an ever-expanding order book for MEP prefabricated solutions.

The move has seen the company double the size of the facility in Walsall, in the West Midlands, to over 40,000 sq ft.
