

## PTSG helps keep vital rescue charity safe

<u>Premier Technical Services Group Ltd (PTSG)</u> has been carrying out specialist water treatment services at the Pwllheli RNLI Lifeboat station, North Wales.

The Pwllheli station is located on the Lleyn Peninsula and operates an all-weather carriage-launched Shannon class lifeboat and an inshore D class lifeboat. Impressively, the crews here have been presented with five awards for gallantry for sea rescues.
