

## PTSG to work at new logistics development

The former AA site, with its vast two-storey underground parking and five-storey above ground design, provided significant challenges to ensure disruption was minimised to businesses on the industrial estate, a nearby hotel, residential blocks and two busy main roads during the demolition and enabling works.
