

RFM awarded NHS contract worth £13.5m

Robertson Facilities Management (RFM) has been selected for the delivery of hard services at the University Hospital of North Durham, which runs until March 2028.

Following a competitive tender, RFM concluded contract documents and subsequently replaced the previous services provider. The team will provide a range of estate services for the 450-bed acute hospital.

Consort, who are the PFI partner of the County Durham and Darlington NHS Foundation Trust, selected RFM following a re-tender process and market test.
