

Wates to manage two regions in national 'Places for People' programme

<u>Wates Group</u>, the one of the leading privately-owned construction, development and property services in the UK, has announced it has been appointed by leading UK social enterprise, <u>Places for People</u>, to upgrade thousands of homes across the central and north east as part of a £104m major works investment framework.

The national programme is managed through six regions, with Wates the only contractor to manage two regions. Its teams will deliver a range of improvements such as new kitchens, doors, and windows as well as exterior painting.

During the four-year contract, more than £40m will be invested across its regions.

Wates Group will be recruiting 84 full-time roles and 42 apprentices and will provide over 1,000 training places and 252 work placements.
