And new for 2023 the Metropolitan Police



Escape Room will test skills and wits in a thrilling cybercrime-solving adventure against the clock.

The event will include educational content, which offers CPD to all attendees courtesy of The Security Institute. There are four main stages – the International Security Conference, the International Risk and Resilience Conference, the Global Counter Terror and Serious and Organised Crime Summit and the Global Cyber Summit, plus two solutions theatres showcasing real-life applications, case studies and the latest product innovations and updates essential to mitigating security threats. The content is delivered by industry experts, government and academia with speakers confirmed from Microsoft, FBI, Home Office, Office for Homeland Security, NaCTSO, NCA, UK Civil Aviation Authority, NATO, Cabinet Office and many more.
