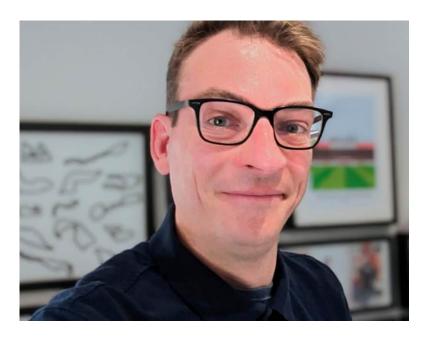


NHSPS Appoints New Head of Data & Intelligence
