

## VINCI Facilities and DIO teams scoop Institute for Collaborative Working (ICW) award

VINCI Facilities Defence and DIO Regional Delivery South East teams have won the prestigious Public/Private Collaborative Working Award at the Institute of Collaborative Working (ICW) Awards, held at the House of Lords on Wednesday 22 November.

## The Award citation reads:

"The judges were impressed how VINCI Facilities has used the principals of Collaboration as a key principle in the innovative contract, promoting mutual trust and support for the benefit of the team of over 1,000 delivering the works to 59 Establishments across the region. This has led to improved benefits, productivity, efficiency, customer satisfaction, social value, energy efficiency flexibility, and added value, continuous improvement, innovation, and team engagement.

The key principle of this innovative contract is its mutual trust & support for mutual benefit, while continuous improvement is the driving force."

The contract, one of the new innovative Future Defence Infrastructure Services (FDIS) contracts was mobilised in April 2022 by VINCI Facilities to provide Hard FM Services to the MOD across the prestigious South East region, including London.

Winning this award so soon after the contract commenced reflects how hard both the VINCI Facilities Defence and DIO teams have worked to form a successful collaborative working relationship.



Earlier this year the VINCI Facilities Defence team also attained the ISO 44001 accreditation for Collaborative Working.
