Under the extended partnership, CBRE GWS will provide a multi-faceted facilities management service for Alstom's critical production and maintenance hubs across the UK, including technical services, cleaning, and waste management.

The extension represents a strengthening of CBRE GWS and Alstom's existing relationship, with CBRE GWS providing facilities management and project management services across a significant portion of Alstom's national estate since 2018.

In the next iteration of the partnership, CBRE GWS's delivery will centre on ensuring Alstom's estate is fit for purpose to deliver the mobility solutions of tomorrow, employing technologies such as predictive risk-based maintenance strategies and creating a bespoke supply chain strategy.

Sustainability is also a key focus of the renewed delivery model, with CBRE implementing environmental best practice initiatives across its supply chain and services to support Alstom's goal of reaching net zero by 2050.
