## The aim

In addition to the HAF program, Vertas' catering team has previously delivered a live cooking demonstration. This time, Vertas' support took the form of a series of workshops led by colleagues from various service areas. These sessions gave the alumni group the necessary advice to bring their 'People Park' to life. This is a project dedicated to creating a safe place for children in the local community to play.

## What happened on the day?

The day was filled with engaging sessions and interactive discussions to empower young people to turn their ideas into reality. During the visit, students learned what to consider when creating a catering establishment. This allowed the group to understand better how to tailor offerings to meet the customer's needs.

Next, the students heard from Vertas Group's Head of Sustainability, Sarah Layton. Sarah spoke about prioritising sustainable practices when building a business and how to minimise environmental impact.



The alumni group then met with Sean Jeffries, Senior Architectural Designer at Concertus Design and Property, to discuss the practical aspects of designing a safe and engaging space. Sean covered the technical considerations of creating a space for young people to enjoy.

The session covered different ways to captivate potential investors and equipped students with the necessary marketing tools to take their project forward.
