

PTSG docks at new Thameside development

The Saxon Wharf development is a residential-led scheme within Greenwich Town Centre. Previously tenanted by a plant hire company, this brownfield site is being redeveloped for our client Notting Hill Genesis to provide 145 new affordable 1, 2 and 3-bedroom homes with 50% shared ownership units and 401sqm of flexible commercial/employment floorspace.

Designed by BPTW architects, the new part 13, part 17-storey building has been arranged to maximise views and access to Deptford Creek. The new development will be car-free, providing parking for blue badge holders only. Instead, the completed scheme will offer storage for a minimum of 244 cycles, and boasts excellent public transport links.

In this contract, engineers from <u>PTSG Electrical Services Ltd</u> will install a new lightning protection system to provide protection for the development in the event of an electrical storm.
