

## PTSG helps Open Golf Championship go with a swing

The 152nd Open Championship took place at Royal Troon Golf Club, South Ayrshire. It is one of the major championships on the PGA Tour and European Tour.

The Old Course begins alongside the sea, running southwards in a line for the first six holes. This opening section offers full visibility and plenty of space, but does still require accuracy to avoid deep bunkers. Many good rounds have been fashioned through low scores here, often aided by prevailing downwind conditions.

NSS Hire, which forms an integral part of PTSG Building Access Specialists Ltd, delivered mobile elevating work platforms (MEWPs), known informally as cherry pickers, to enable broadcasters to capture a wide range of footage of the golf championship from some spectacular positions and heights.
