

PTSG's Group Assessor completes charity half-marathon

On Sunday 17 August, Paul Campbell, Group NVQ Assessor at <u>Premier Technical Services Group Ltd (PTSG)</u> completed the Scottish Half-Marathon on behalf of two highly deserving charities.

The event is staged each year in Edinburgh, taking runners along the magnificent East Lothian Golf Coast before finishing in the final furlong at Musselburgh Racecourse; Scotland's oldest racecourse. The course is flat, which means many runners are able to achieve a PB (personal best).
