As with the UK's other national galleries and museums, there is no admission charge for access to the collection displays, which take up the majority of the gallery space, whereas tickets must be purchased for the major temporary exhibitions. The gallery recovered strongly after being closed for much of the COVID pandemic in 2020; it is now the third most visited museum in Britain and the fourth most visited art museum in the world.

Mansafe systems comprising stainless steel wire rope, posts and fixings provide users with an approved, tested and inspected method of safe access/work.
