

PTSG to work at Brent Cross Town regeneration

<u>Premier Technical Services Group Ltd (PTSG)</u> has been contracted to deliver specialist Access & Safety services at the Brent Cross Town regeneration scheme.

Earlier this year, construction contractor Galliford Try completed the first build-to-rent building at the Brent Cross Town regeneration scheme. Located on Neighbourhood Square in the heart of the town centre, it will feature 249 new rental homes alongside residents' amenities over three new blocks.

In addition to providing new accommodation, new office buildings and flexible small business spaces – as well as a new high street – are planned to make the development a great place to work as well as to live and spend quality time.

Work is now underway is plat 14, which will feature 286 apartments with a range of amenities for residents. Engineers from PTSG Access & Safety Ltd will design, supply, install and commission a rope access davit system, rope access traditional boxes and self-retracting lifelines.
