

Polyteck Secures Four-Year Maintenance Contract with Richmond Housing Partnership

Polyteck has secured a four-year contract to provide maintenance services for Richmond Housing Partnership (RHP), as part of Fusion21's £346 million Building Improvements Framework.

Under the terms of the contract, Polyteck will deliver services including the refurbishment of kitchens and bathrooms across RHP's portfolio.
