- Rainwater harvesting & greywater recycling: For reduced servicing and improved water efficiency.
- Next-generation lithium battery and smart telemetry: Ensures silent, continuous operation while optimising fuel and carbon usage.

Setting up and moving the ECOWC2 is a seamless process. The towable unit can be easily transported without heavy-duty vehicles, making it cost-effective and accessible for any site location. Its unique retractable drawbar minimises onsite footprint and a tough, anti-vandal steel structure guarantees durability in even the most demanding environments.

With the ECOWC2, there's also no compromise on quality. The unit includes a 600L waste tank, enough to handle 1,200 uses, and a 400L freshwater tank, allowing for longer service intervals. From soap dispensers to automatic LED lighting, each feature is designed to support a safer, cleaner, and more efficient work environment.

The ECOWC2 unit comes equipped with Smart Telemetry, which provides live and historical usage data.
