


Association for Rental Living Expo returns, enabling the FM sector to 'Make the Connection' in 2025

New for the 2025 event will be a series of Fireside Chats. These engaging features will provide delegates with access to key influencers within the rental living sector and focus on key issues facing the sector this year. Professionalising the sector – the Expo will also additionally feature a series of training sessions throughout the day for rental living sector professionals at all stages of their careers at attend. Led by the ARL's Education and Qualifications Committee, these new sessions demonstrate the organisation's commitment to professionalising the sector.

The 2025 ARL Expo will also feature the FM Fever – an energetic, timed event where facilities maintenance challenges see teams compete against each other to prove their mettle. Following this ever-popular session, the delegate drinks reception will offer the perfect opportunity to further network in a relaxed setting.
