

# Serco awarded landmark UK Armed Forces Recruitment Service programme

[Serco](#), the international provider of critical government services, has today been selected to deliver the Ministry of Defence's next-generation recruiting solution for the Royal Navy, the British Army, the Royal Air Force and Strategic Command following a rigorous competitive process. The contract sees recruitment for these branches of the military brought together for the first time.

The Armed Forces Recruitment Service (AFRS) contract, will be for seven years, plus options for a further three one-year extensions. A 21-month mobilisation period is expected to begin in April 2025 with the new service commencing in early 2027.
