The unit's hydrostatic transmission and three-way dumping capability allow for precise material handling, a major advantage for the company's utility and

The Yanmar C12R-C features an operating weight of 1,100 kg and a payload capacity of 1,150 kg, all within a compact 960 mm width; making it an ideal solution for sites with restricted access. Its hydrostatic transmission ensures smooth operation, while its three-way dumping capability allows materials to be offloaded to the rear or either side.

Richard emphasised how this flexibility has transformed operations, making the transport of spoil, aggregates, and trench fill far more efficient. Since its arrival in October, the dumper has been deployed across various utility and groundworks projects, proving to be an essential addition to the fleet.
