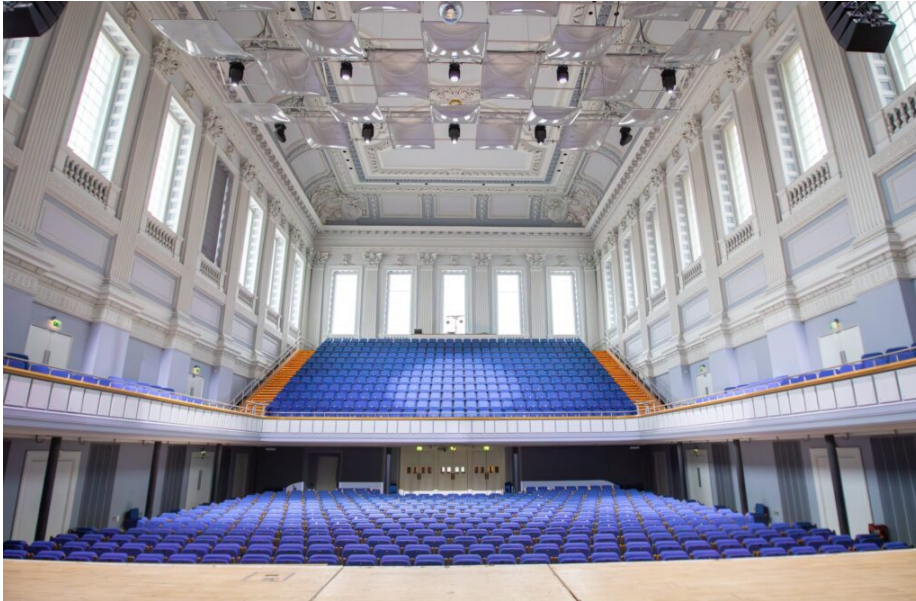


Pareto FM Awarded M&E and Fabric Contract at Iconic B:Music Birmingham Venue
