


## PTSG Helps Bring World Record-Breaking London Marathon to Screens Around the Globe

Among the standout performances on race day, Ethiopia's Tigst Assefa won the women's race in a new world record for a women-only field, while Kenya's Sebastian Sawe claimed victory in the men's event.
