

<u>Legrand CPD to Enhance Fire Safety</u> <u>Knowledge</u>

<u>Premature collapse and fire rated containment</u> explores the current UK standards landscape that applies to cable management systems which do not currently require any fire testing. As part of this commitment, Legrand confirmed its Swifts and Salamandre ranges of cable tray, ladder and trunking had been tested and withstood collapse in line with DIN 4102-12 – a German standard that considers the fire resistance of electrical cable systems required to main circuit integrity during a fire event.

However, we are often asked for clarification regarding cable management systems and their role within the built environment particularly with regards to fire safety.
