

EnvirotechFM hits the right notes with new contract win

<u>EnvirotechFM</u> has secured a contract to deliver facilities management services at a brand-new state-of-the-art concert venue located in the heart of London.

More than a century after the first Bechstein Hall opened in London, the German piano manufacturer returned to Wigmore Street in late 2024 to open new £40m premises that include a 100-seat concert venue, flagship showroom, practice rooms, bar and restaurant.
