

<u>Sitemark Team Takes on 38-Mile 'Paddle,</u> <u>Plod & Pedal' Challenge for St Richard's</u> <u>Hospice</u>

The <u>Sitemark</u> team is set to tackle a monumental 38-mile charity challenge on September 27, 2025, to raise funds for St Richard's Hospice.

The challenge will see the team:

- Paddle 13.8 miles from Pershore to Tewkesbury.
- Plod a 10-mile hike from Tewkesbury to Severn Stoke.
