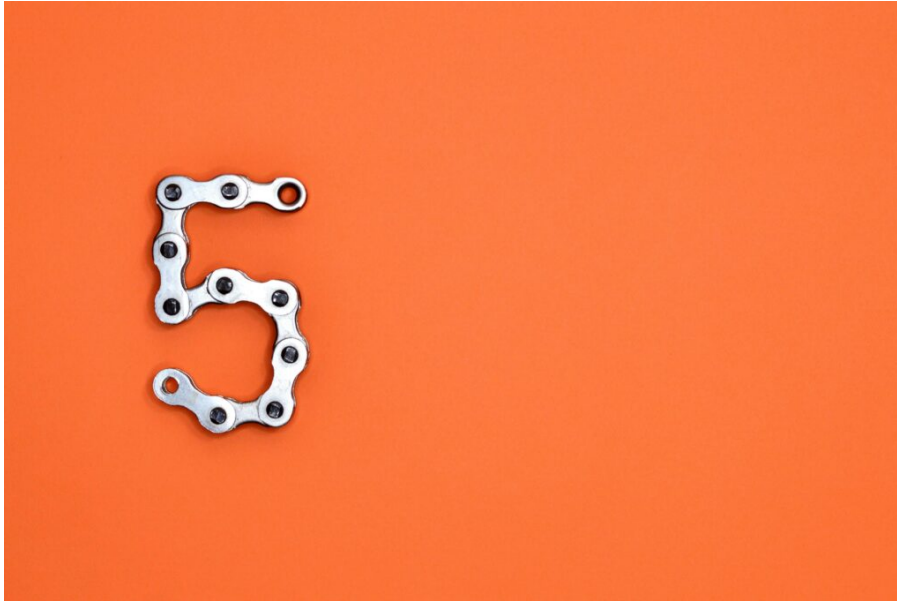


# FM Business Daily's Top 5 Stories of 2025: AI Integration, People-Power, and Sustainability Dominate the Conversation
