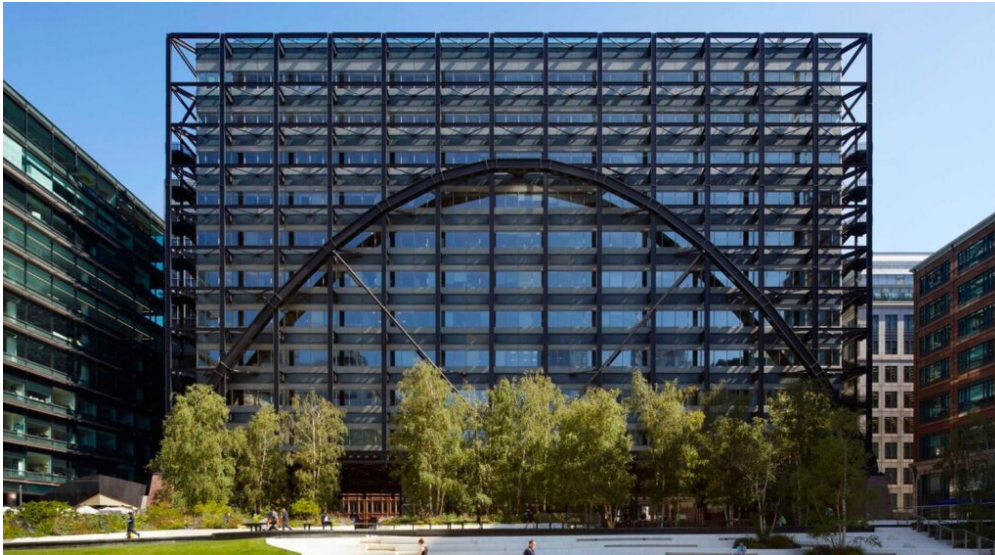


## Portfolio Wins Cleaning Contract with Herbert Smith Freehills Kramer
