As part of its commitments under the scheme, PTSG has pledged to ensure its recruitment process is as inclusive and accessible as possible. This includes offering an interview to disabled applicants who meet the minimum criteria for a role, to anticipate and provide reasonable adjustments and to support any existing employee who acquires a disability or long-term health condition to remain in work.

Terry Wilcock, Health and Wellbeing Director who leads on this area for PTSG, said: “Becoming Disability Confident Committed is an important step for us. We want PTSG to be a place where everyone has a fair opportunity to contribute and grow, and this accreditation gives us a clear framework to build on.
