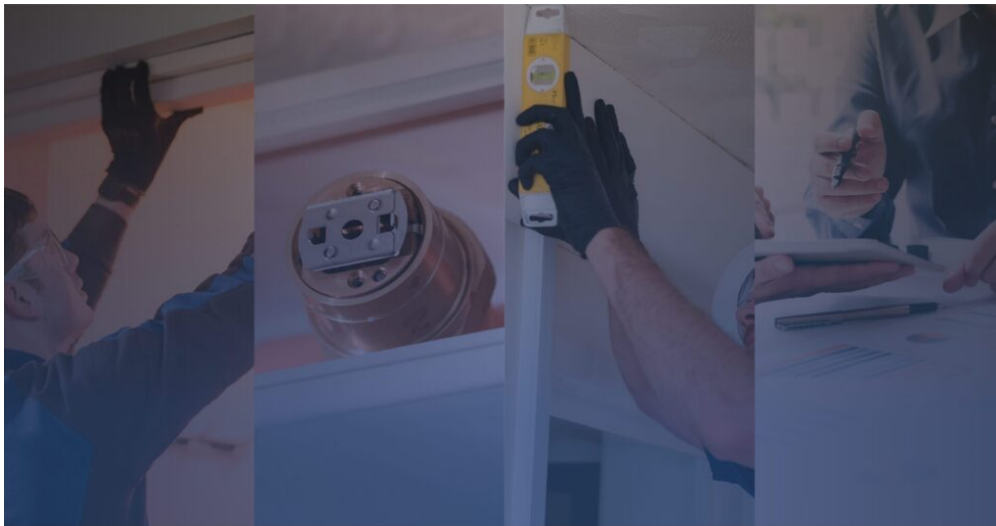


Harmony Fire Secures £695 Million Procure Plus Framework Appointment
